RULE 27 — CUSTOMER'S EQUIPMENT — MOBILE HOMES

a. <u>Definition of Mobile Home:</u>

Definition - A mobile home is a factory-assembled structure or structures transportable in one or more sections that is build on a permanent chassis and designed to be used as a dwelling without a permanent foundation where connected to the required utilities, and includes the plumbing, heating, air-conditioning, and electric systems contained therein.

b. Mobile Home Service Equipment:

The mobile home service equipment shall be located adjacent to the mobile home and not mounted in or on the mobile home. **Sketch #42**, **Sketch #43**, **Sketch #44** and **Sketch #45** illustrate typical mobile home electric services.

c. **Grounding:**

The grounding conductor and service entrance equipment shall be grounded in accordance with, or better than, the latest edition of the National Electrical Code (NEC) or any other applicable code.
