Know the signs of a natural gas leak.

The distinctive, sulfur-like odor of natural gas can be a sure sign of a leak, but some leaks don't have an odor at all.

Use your other senses to detect a leak:

- Hissing, whistling or roaring sounds
- Dirt blowing into the air from a hole in the ground
- Continuous bubbling in water
- Dead or dying vegetation in an otherwise moist area

Leaks can also occur:

- After a fire or flood if a pipeline is exposed
- In a damaged connection to a gas appliance

If you suspect a gas leak, assume there's danger and take these steps:

- Warn others and leave the area quickly. Take everyone with you including pets.
- **DO NOT** use the telephone or any electrical appliances — including light switches, garage door openers, doorbells, radios, TVs, cell phones, e-cigarettes or vape pens. A spark from any of these sources could ignite the gas, causing a fire or explosion.
- From a safe location, call **911** and Rhode Island Energy. Provide the leak location, including cross streets, and let us know if sewer construction or digging activities are going on in the area.
- **DO NOT** go back inside your home or building until Rhode Island Energy personnel say it is safe to return.
