Dear customer,

We have received your inquiry into terminating your awarded conditional Certificate of Eligibility (COE) issued on the date and with interconnection case number provided below. Completing this form, returning it to your Rhode Island Energy CEI job owner, and receiving a confirmation email from that Rhode Island Energy CEI job owner will serve as your official request for termination.

Rhode Island Energy must comply with the Rhode Island Renewable Energy Growth Program Tariff for Non-Residential Customers, for Program Year 2024, RIPUC No. 2152-K (Tariff), including Section 11 titled “Termination Provisions.” Section 11 of the Tariff reads, in part, as follows:

“The Applicant and the Customer may not terminate their obligations under this Tariff unless and until the Company consents to such termination. The Company will not unreasonably delay or withhold its consent to an Applicant’s request to terminate if the Applicant cannot fulfill the obligations because of an event or circumstance that is beyond the Applicant’s reasonable control and for which the Applicant could not prevent or provide against by using commercially reasonable efforts.”

Rhode Island Energy will review your request to terminate, based primarily on the information provided below. Termination of Certificates of Eligibility will be issued on a case-by-case basis if the Company determines the provided reasoning and documented evidence satisfies the standard contained in Section 11 of the Tariff, as well as any applicable rulings by the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission (PUC).
