Dear Ms. De La Rosa:

On behalf of The Narragansett Electric Company d/b/a Rhode Island Energy (the "Company"), enclosed, please find the Company's First Open Enrollment Report for the 2025 Rhode Island Renewable Energy ("RE") Growth Program (the "Report"). This Report is being filed in accordance with R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26.6-20(a) and (b).

The Company is seeking the issuance of an order from the Public Utilities Commission ("PUC") awarding a certificate of eligibility ("COE") to one (1) commercial scale solar project detailed in Attachment 3.

In total, the Company selected eight (8) projects for a COE in the First 2025 Open Enrollment, totaling 1,741 kW of project nameplate capacity.

The Report consists of the following attachments:

• <u>Attachment 1</u> is entitled First 2025 Rhode Island Renewable Energy Growth Program Open Enrollment Report. This attachment lists the eight (8) projects that the Company has selected for a COE.

The list includes seven (7) medium-scale solar projects. In accordance with R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26.6-20(a), the selected medium-scale solar projects are to be provided a COE by the Company without approval from the PUC subject to the review and consent of the Office of Energy Resources ("OER").

This list also includes one (1) Commercial-Scale Solar I project. In accordance with R.I. Gen. Laws § 39-26.6-20(b), this project is subject to approval by the PUC. Attachment 3 contains the COE for the project and contains the corresponding pricing information.

Payment Option: Option 1

Residential Customers automatically receive Option 2. For Non-Residential Customers, subject to the conditions set forth in Section 8.c of the Non-Residential Tariff, an Applicant must notify the Company of the manner by which it will be compensated for its output under the Program. Option 1 – Direct payment of the entire PBI or Option 2 – a combination of direct payment and customer bill credit.

Output Certification Deadline: To be Determined

If the Output Certification is not received within the required timeframe, subject to the conditions set forth in Section 3 of the Tariff, the project's Certificate of Eligibility will be voided and its performance guarantee deposit will be forfeited. Once a DG Project has provided the Output Certification, the Project then has 90 days to meet all other requirements pursuant to Section 8.a. of the Tariff in order to receive payment.

Certificate Effective Date: To be Determined

The standard performance-based incentive is paid beginning on this date for the applicable term of the tariff. As a condition of receiving payments, the Applicant must provide confirmation of: 1) the Company's written authority to interconnect to its electric distribution system and Applicant's payment of all amounts due; 2) Commission certification of the DG Project as an Eligible Renewable Energy Resource; 3) registration of the DG Project with the ISO-NE and NEPOOL GIS; 4) a copy of the Project's approved State of Rhode Island Solar Permit or building permit, including the responsible Rhode Island General Contractor's Number; and 5) except for small-scale and medium-scale solar, the Output Certification.

Certificate Termination Date: To be Determined

The performance-based incentive is paid up to this date covering the applicable 20-year term of the tariff. Section 11 of the Non-Residential Tariff highlights termination provisions under which the tariff might be terminated earlier than the stated Certificate Termination Date.
