Efficiency Programs

Rhode Island Energy (RI Energy), Clean Heat RI, and the New England Heat Pump Accelerator (NE HPA) offer incentives for replacing your existing heating and cooling equipment with high efficiency air source heat pumps (ASHPs).

Switching from electric baseboard to ASHPs opportunities:

- RI Energy Financing* - 0% Interest Loan
- RI Energy Enhanced Customer Incentive* - \$1,500 per ton
- NE HPA Distributor Incentive* - \$650 per unit

** RI Energy Financing, and RI Energy, and NE HPA incentives can be applied to the same equipment*

Switching from natural gas, oil, or propane to ASHPs opportunities:

- RI Energy Standard Customer Incentive* - Up to \$625 per ton
- Clean Heat RI Customer Incentive* - 60% of cost (up to \$11,500)
- NE HPA Distributor Incentive* - \$650 per unit (ask your contractor)

** RI Energy, Clean Heat RI, and NE HPA incentives can be applied to the same equipment. Note: requires separate application and guidelines*
